

Timber Ridge Forest Preserve West Chicago

Location

The main entrance is on the west side of County Farm Road 1 mile south of North Avenue (Route 64). Additional parking is on Prince Crossing Road 0.4 mile south of North Avenue and 0.3 mile north of Geneva Road.

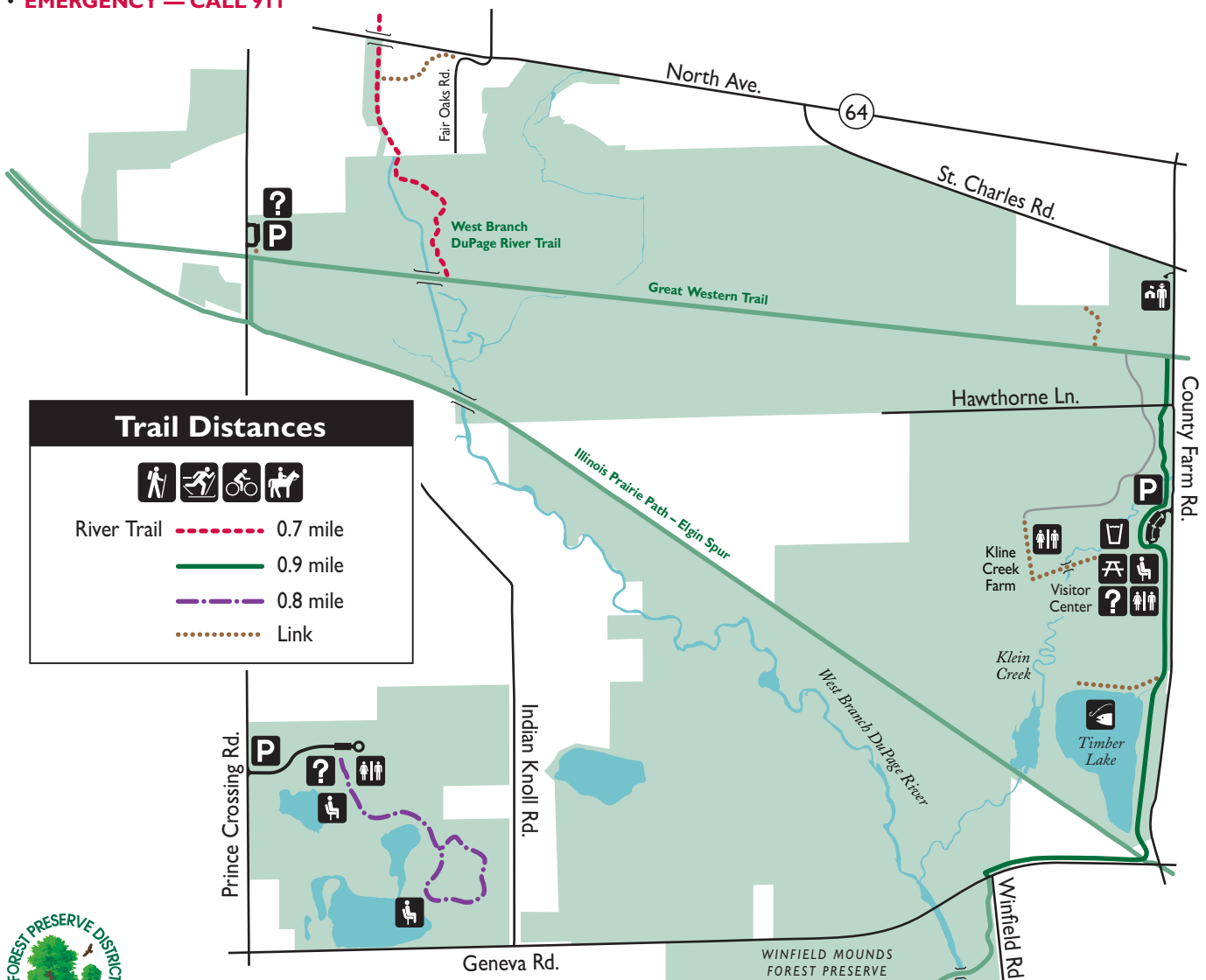
Preserve Features





- Trailhead for Great Western Trail and Illinois Prairie Path
- Woodland environment
- Klein Creek and the West Branch of the DuPage River
- Home of the 200-acre Kline Creek Farm, an 1890s living-history farm
- Kline Creek Farm and Timber Ridge Visitor Center open 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.
Thursdays – Mondays and closed Tuesdays, Wednesdays and select holidays
- Visitor center restrooms open daily
- Timber Lake accessible by 0.5-mile footpath along crushed-limestone trail

Please Be Aware

- Bicycles, horses and pets not allowed in farmstead
- Drinking fountains accessible only during visitor center hours
- Open daily one hour after sunrise until one hour after sunset
