Blackwell Forest Preserve West Branch DuPage River Trail Closure

The Forest Preserve District is building a new campus for our grounds and natural resources crews here at Blackwell.

The project requires a new water main under the West Branch DuPage River Trail along McKee Marsh. As a result, a section of the trail (highlighted on the map in yellow) will temporarily close.

When work begins we'll post detour signs at key intersections to help you avoid the closed section as you walk, bike, or ride horseback between Gary's Mill Road, the McKee Marsh parking lot, and the Mack Road trail crossing.


