

Olmec Trails: Culture and Legacy

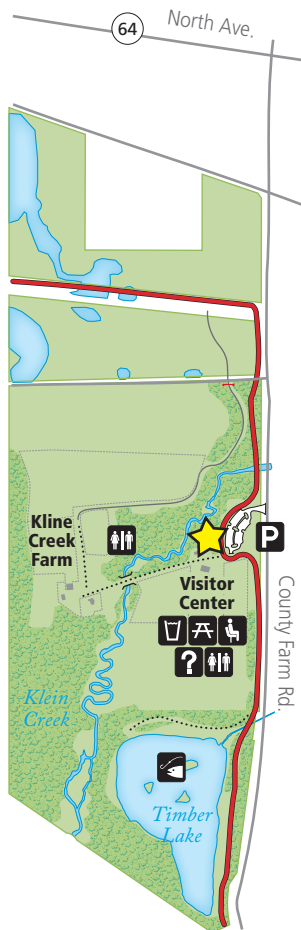
June – October 2024

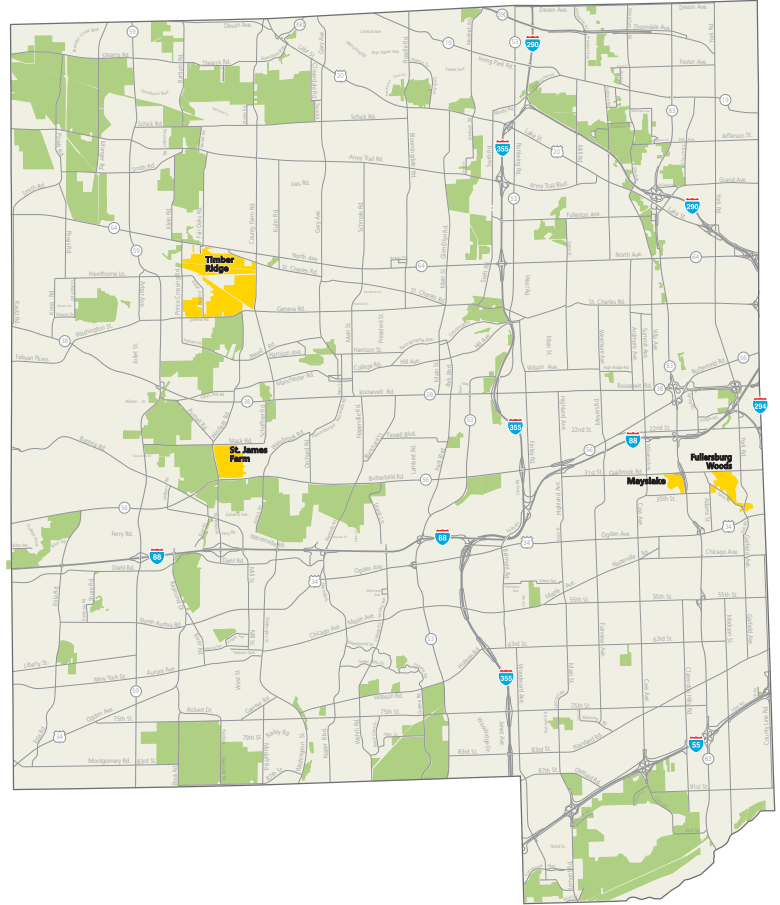

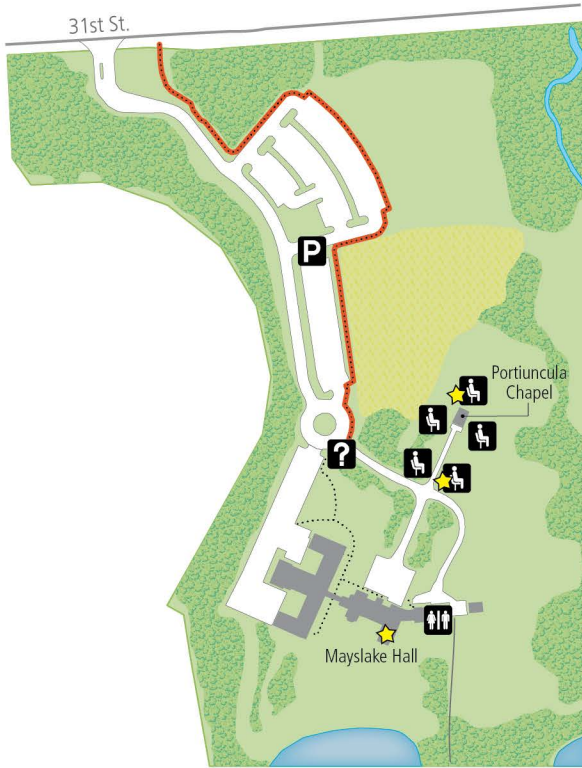

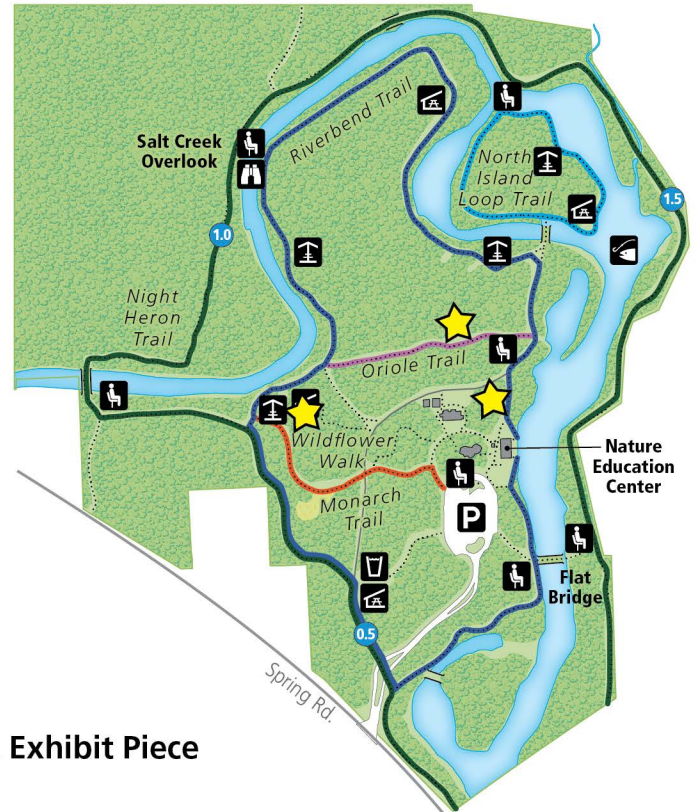
