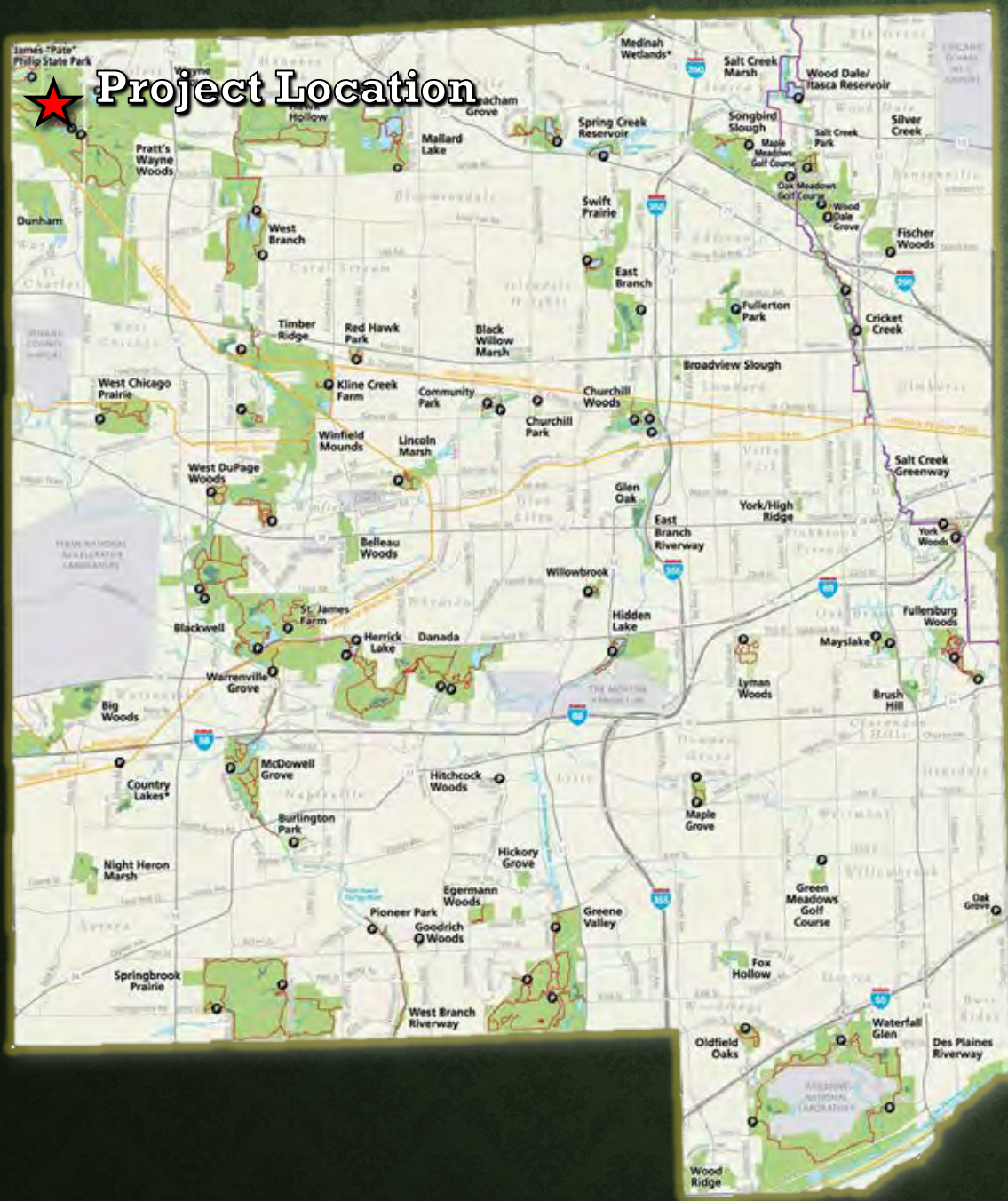


# RTP GRANT

- The Recreational Trails Program is a federally funded program designed to assist federal, state, and local agencies with land acquisition and development of multi-purpose recreational trails. Trails must typically be in natural setting and support equestrian use.
- Reimbursable grant of which 80% of costs are covered up to a maximum of \$200,000.
- Applications due March 2, 2020
- Projects must be completed within two years from acceptance of notice of award.







# LOCATION MAP

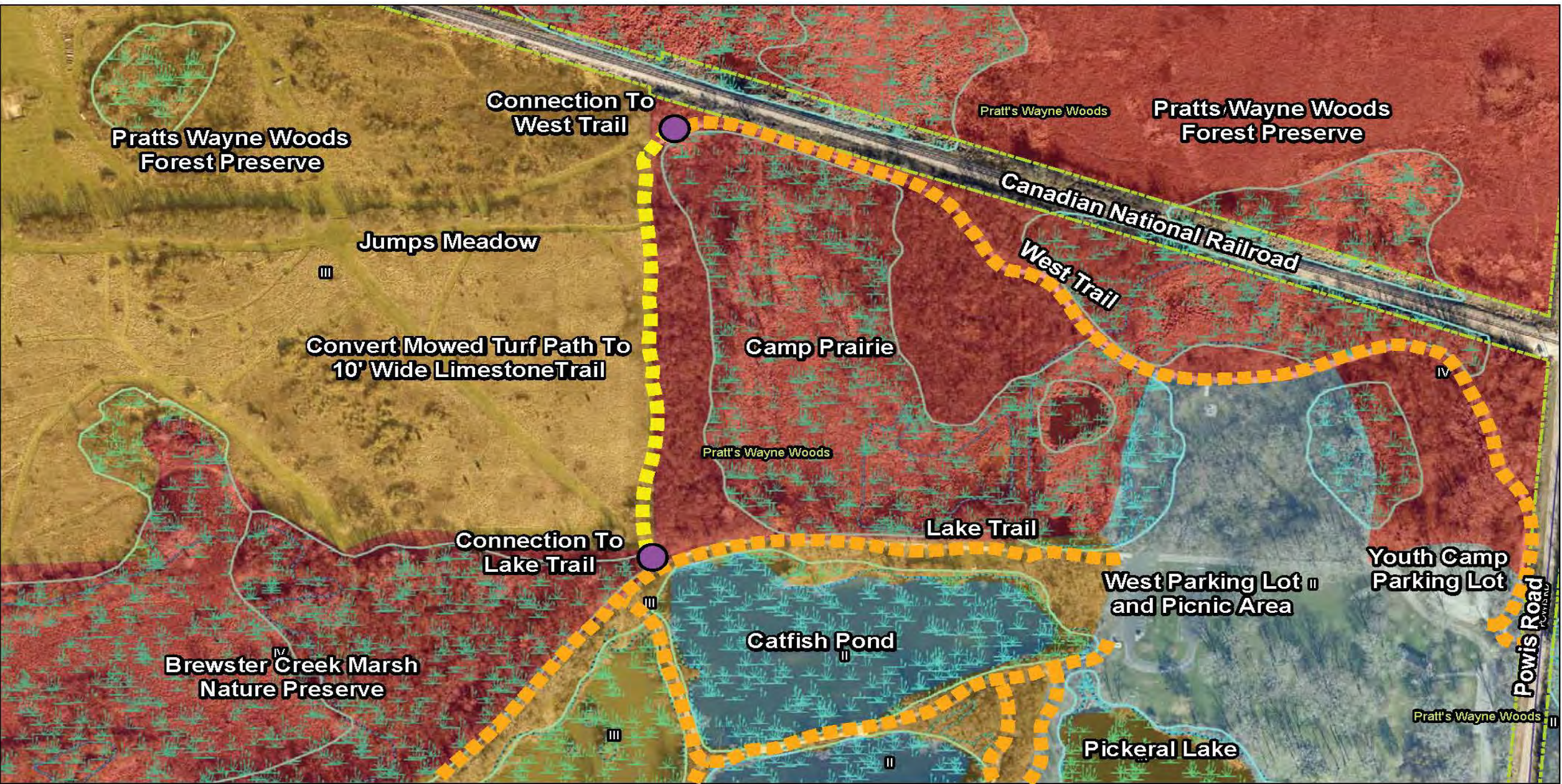

# PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

- Conversion of .3 miles of a 10' wide turf trail to a 10' wide limestone multi-purpose trail that would complete a paved loop trail between the West Trail and Lake Trail improving year round use for visitors and access for Grounds Management staff.

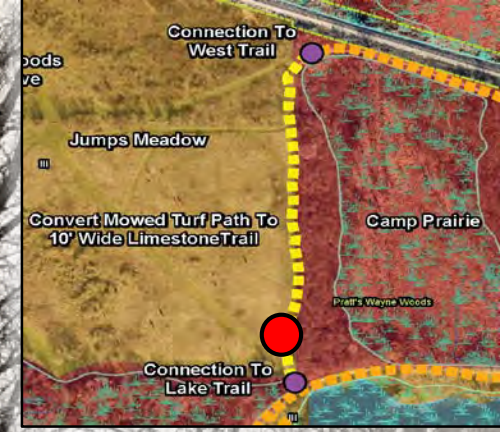

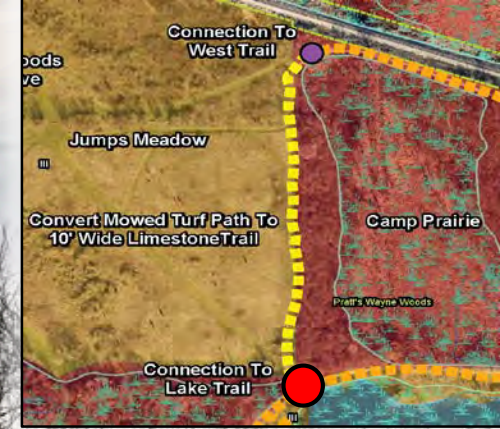

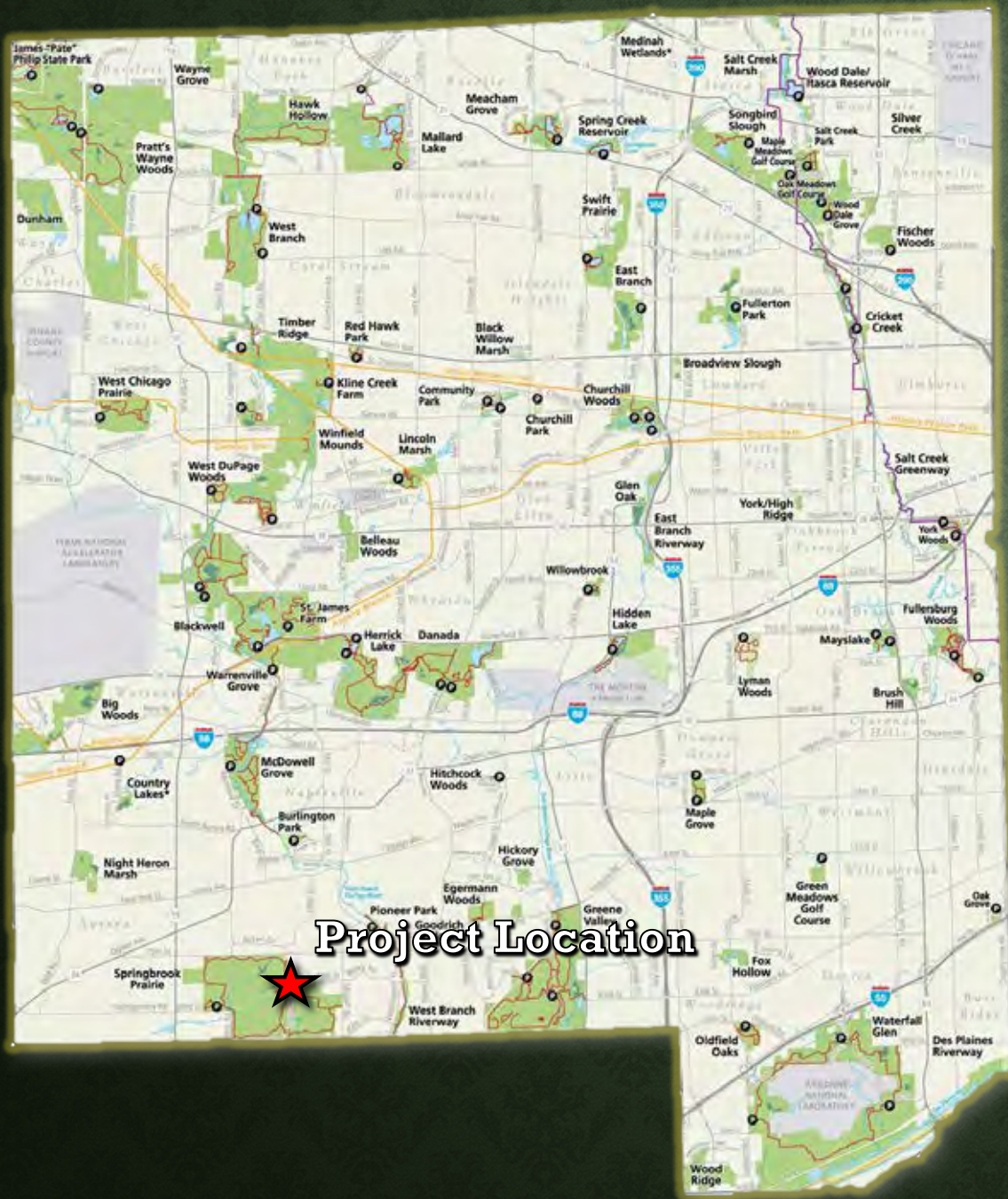


# BPP GRANT

- The Bike Path Grant Program is a state funded program designed to assist local agencies with land acquisition and development of or renovation to public off-road non-motorized bike paths that are linear in nature. Regional trails and their connections are given priority.
- Reimbursable grant of which 50% of costs are covered up to a maximum of \$200,000.
- Applications due March 16, 2020
- Projects must be completed within two years from acceptance of notice of award.







# LOCATION MAP

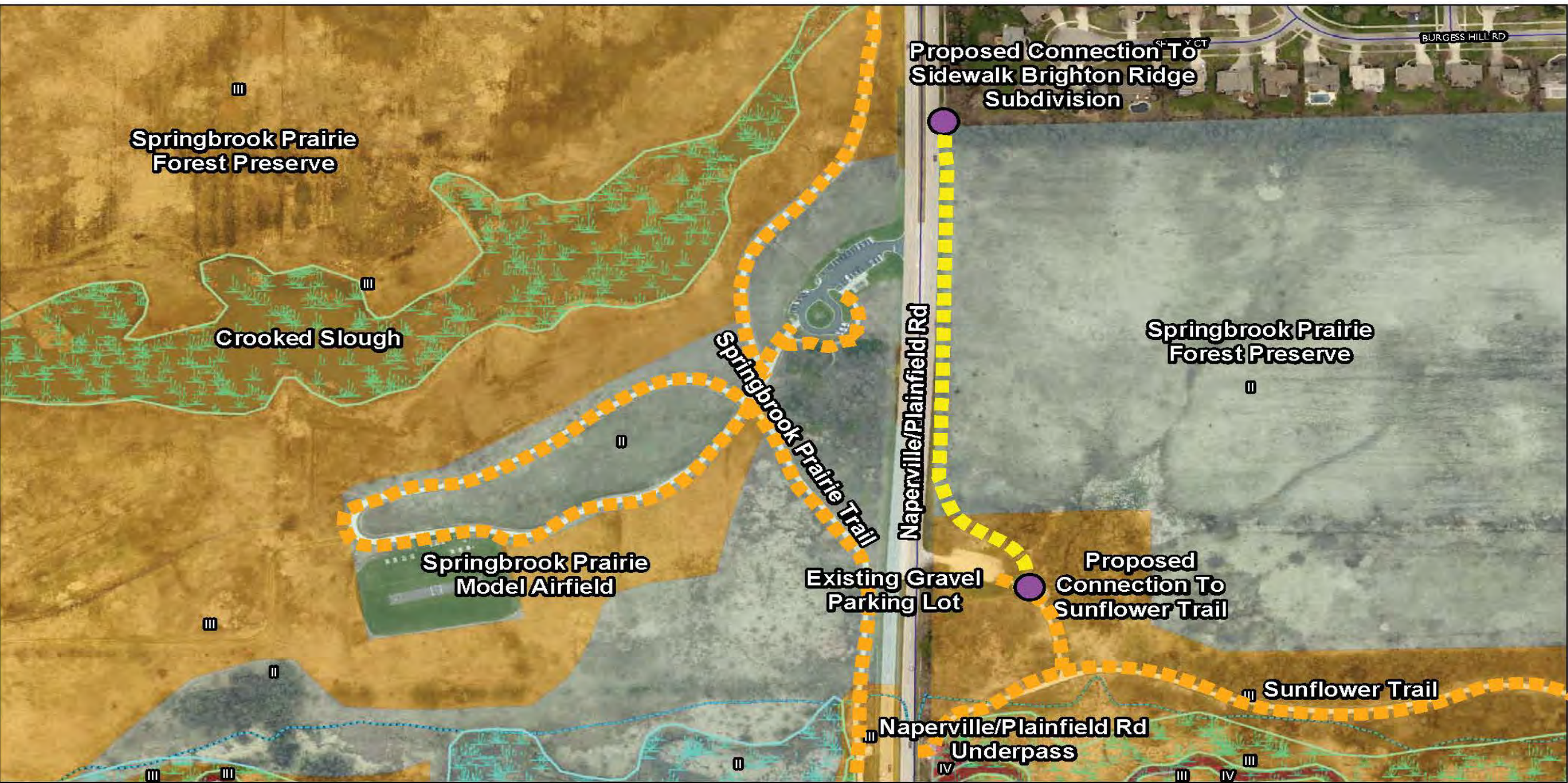

# PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

- Construction of .25 miles of a 10' wide limestone multi-purpose trail along the east side of Naperville/Plainfield Road between the end of the Bailey Road sidewalk and Springbrook Prairie's Sunflower Trail south of Brighton Ridge Subdivision.
