

Mayslake Forest Preserve Oak Brook

Location

The main entrance is on 31st Street/Oak Brook Road 0.4 mile west of Route 83. The entrance to the off-leash dog area is on St. Paschal's Drive 0.4 mile south of 31st Street/Oak Brook Road.

Preserve Features

- 87-acre preserve
- Historic Mayslake Peabody Estate with Mayslake Hall, the Portiuncula Chapel and the First Folio Theatre outdoor stage
- 3 acres of fishing on Trinity Lake and 8 acres of fishing on Mays' Lake with largemouth bass, bluegill, catfish and crappie

Please Be Aware

- District permit required to use off-leash dog area
- Sections of Trinity and Mays' lakes on private property
- Open daily one hour after sunrise until one hour after sunset

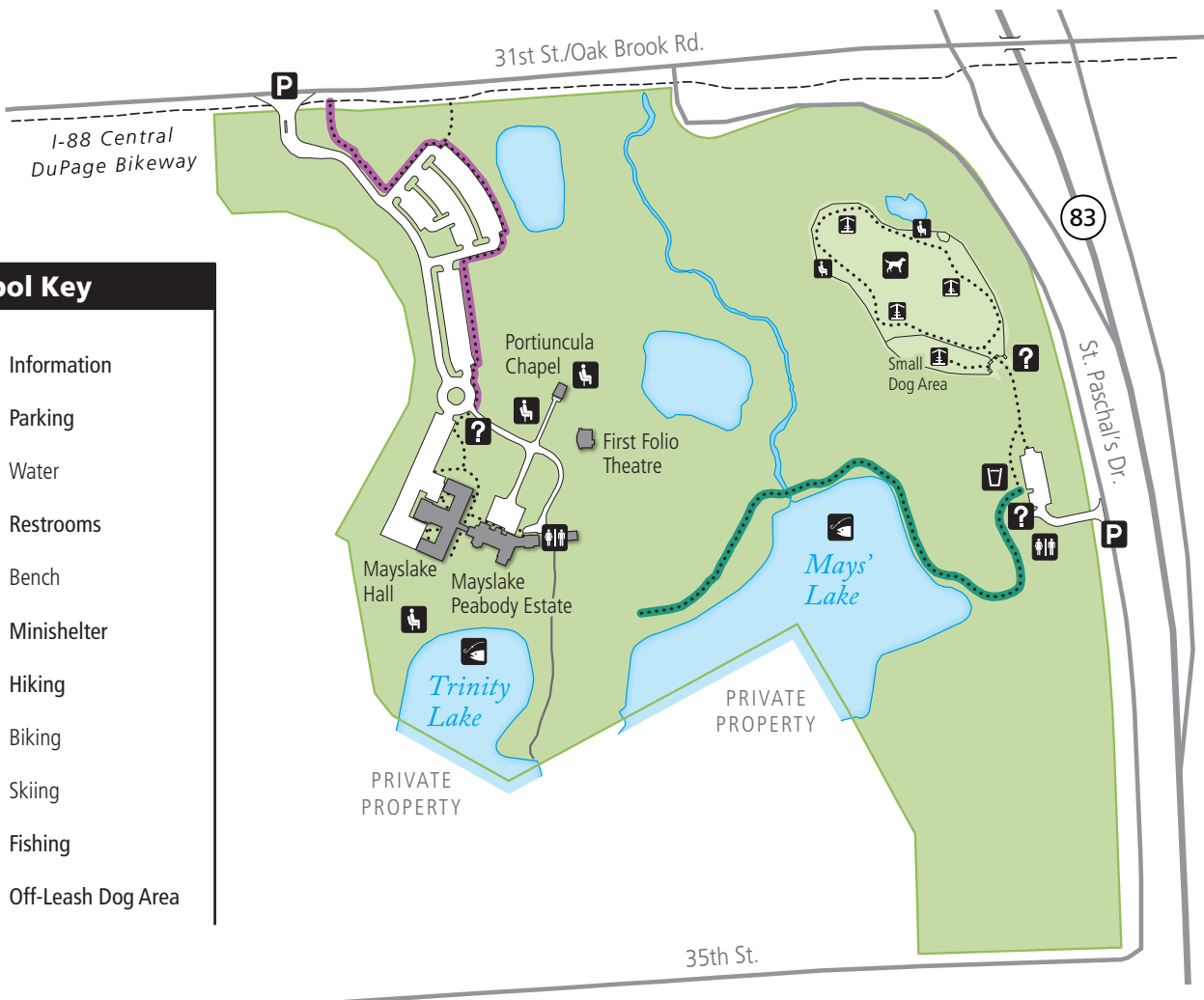
