Registration opens at **dupageforest.org/camps** on **Feb. 15** for DuPage residents and **March 1** for nonresidents. (If you're reading this as on online PDF, you can click on the name of the camp to get to the registration page.)

To keep conditions as safe as possible, each camper must wear a mask that covers the nose and mouth. All camps will emphasize social distancing and have a limit of 10 campers unless otherwise noted.

Unless noted, camps are five days Monday – Friday and are \$150 for DuPage residents and \$175 for nonresidents.
