Instructions The photographer must complete and submit this application. A client cannot submit it on a photographer's behalf.

Apply for a permit at least five business days in advance one of three ways.

You must provide a certificate of insurance that remains current for the duration of your still portrait photography permit and has 1) your name (the photographer) as the insured, 2) \$1,000,000 in liability coverage for each occurrence, 3) a \$2,000,000 general aggregate limit, and 4) the Forest Preserve District of DuPage County, 3S580 Naperville Road, Wheaton, IL 60189 as the certificate holder and as an additional insured with the location and purpose listed under the description of operations.

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Fees Fees are nonrefundable (even for cancellations due to weather), and permits are nontransferable. You can change a daily permit one time up to one week in advance for a \$5 fee. There's a \$5 fee to replace a lost or stolen annual permit.

DuPage County resident or studio or Annual permit (valid Jan. – Dec.) \$200 One-time permit (max. three hours) \$55 agency office in DuPage

All other photographers Annual permit (valid Jan. – Dec.) \$250 One-time permit (max. three hours) \$75

There may be additional fees for special requests such as permission to use oversized props, to drive to sites other than designated parking areas, or to hold photo shoots at certain locations.

Payment Information

Once the Forest Preserve District receives your application, a representative from Visitor Services will contact you within three business days to arrange for payment and verification of your certificate of insurance. You will not receive a permit until we receive both.

Rules and Regulations and Waiver

Please read this information carefully. It includes releases of liability and waiver of legal rights and deprives you of the ability to sue certain parties. By checking the boxes and providing your name and the date, you acknowledge you've read and understood all of the text.

Rules and Regulations

For everyone's safety and enjoyment, you must follow these rules and regulations, which the Forest Preserve District may change at any time.

- Carry and display your permit during any for-profit photo shoot, and present it to a Forest Preserve District agent for inspection if requested.
- Ensure your certificate of insurance remains current for the duration of your still portrait photography permit.
- If you have an annual permit, notify Visitor Services of all photo shoots at least five business days in advance.
- Hold photo shoots only during regular forest preserve hours (one hour after sunrise until one hour after sunset), and make sure they do not last more than three hours. The Forest Preserve District may prohibit a shoot if you do not provide additional requested information or if the shoot might conflict with previously scheduled activities, damage property, affect other forest preserve visitors, or use restricted areas.
- The Forest Preserve District may restrict the number of people in a shoot or the use of models, sets or props. Props are especially restricted at Danada Equestrian Center, Fullersburg Woods Nature Education Center, Kline Creek Farm, Mayslake Peabody Estate and Willowbrook Wildlife Center. Alcoholic beverages are always prohibited.
- Park only in designated areas. Do not block trails, roads or parking lots or prevent other forest preserve visitors from accessing any areas. Your permit does not grant you exclusive use of an area.
- Do not disrupt Forest Preserve District employees or ask them to deviate from their normal duties to accommodate your shoot.
- Only photograph contracted participants; do not photograph other forest preserve visitors or Forest Preserve District employees or vehicles.
- Do not solicit, advertise or collect fees on Forest Preserve District property.

By checking the box below I agree to abide by these rules and regulations as well as all Forest Preserve District ordinances and administrative orders and state statutes. I understand that the Forest Preserve District may fine me or revoke my permit without refunding my permit fee if I supply false information on this application or fail to comply with any rules, regulations, ordinances, orders or statutes.
