Instructions *The leader who will be on-site during the group's entire stay must complete and submit this application.*

Apply for a permit at least seven business days in advance one of four ways.

Requirements

- The youth-group cabin and campgrounds are for the exclusive use of youth groups, which are defined as recognized, nonprofit organizations whose members are 17 or younger. A recognized group must be organized with by-laws, have an Article of Incorporation filed with the Secretary of State, and be insured on forest preserve property with a current certificate of insurance on file.
- Only members of qualifying groups with their accompanying leaders may camp in these areas.
- Adult supervision of one group leader 21 or older for every 10 members 17 or younger is mandatory for the duration of the stay.
- As soon as possible, you must submit a valid Council Charter Certificate (if a Scouting event) or a certificate of insurance. Charter certificates must be valid for the specific camping dates and can be emailed to permits@dupageforest.org or faxed to 630-933-7217.

Rules and Regulations and Waiver

Please read this information carefully. It includes releases of liability and waiver of legal rights and deprives you of the ability to sue certain parties. By checking the boxes and providing your name and the date, you acknowledge you’ve read and understood all of the text.

Rules and Regulations

For everyone’s safety and enjoyment, you must follow these rules and regulations, which the Forest Preserve District may change at any time.

- As the permit holder, you must be at the cabin or campground at your set check-in time with your permit and remain on-site for the duration of your group’s stay. **Only members of your qualifying youth group with their accompanying leaders can camp at your site.**
- You must have adult supervision of one leader 21 or older for every 10 members 17 or younger for the duration of your group’s stay.
- Do not bring alcoholic beverages into the forest preserve, campground or cabin; alcohol is strictly prohibited.
- Stay near your site after dusk and remain in the campground when the forest preserve is closed (one hour after sunset until one hour after sunrise). Guests must leave by 10 p.m.
- Do not enter another site without permission from an adult leader from that group.
- Do not tent camp at the Herrick Lake youth-group cabin.
- Do not trench around tents, attach clotheslines or lanterns to trees, or otherwise disrupt the natural environment.
- Do not bring outside firewood or cut or collect live or dead wood. Firewood is provided.
- Keep ground fires within the designated fire ring. Extinguish your fire and make sure it’s cold to the touch before you leave your site.
- Keep your site clean and put trash in the appropriate garbage or recycling containers. After you pack up, make sure your site looks as it did when you arrived.
- If you use stereos or similar equipment, only do so between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. and only at volumes that do not disturb others. Use gasoline or diesel engines or generators only during these times as well. Keep all noise to a minimum after 10 p.m.
- Pets are not allowed at the Herrick Lake cabin. If you bring pets to one of the other youth-group campgrounds, stay with them at all times; do not tie them to any trees, plants, buildings or equipment; always keep them leashed and quiet; and pick up any waste.

By checking the box below I agree to abide by these rules and regulations as well as all Forest Preserve District ordinances and administrative orders and state statutes. I understand that the Forest Preserve District may fine me or revoke my permit without refunding my permit fee if I supply false information on this application or fail to comply with any rules, regulations, ordinances, orders or statutes.
