

NATURE SUNCATCHER

Collect signs of nature from your backyard, and use them to make a colorful suncatcher to hang in a window or outdoors!



You'll Need

Flowers, leaves and grasses from your yard

Two self-adhesive laminating sheets

Scissors

Hole punch

Piece of yarn or string

Directions

1. Take a walk around your yard and collect small flowers, leaves and grasses.
2. Peel the backing from one of the self-adhesive laminated sheets. Place the sheet on a table with the sticky side facing up. On the sticky side, arrange your flowers, leaves and grasses. (You may want to put them more toward the center so you can easily cut around them later.)
3. Peel the backing from the second sheet. Place the second sheet on top of your flowers, leaves and grasses sticky side down.
4. Press down to seal in your flowers, leaves and grasses.
5. Cut a shape out of the laminated sheets. (For this example we traced a bowl.)
6. Use the hole punch to place a hole at the top of your suncatcher.
7. Tie a piece of string through the hole, and hang your artwork in a sunny place!
